



### **CCNC Pregnancy Medical Home Program – Priority Risk Factors**

1. Multifetal gestation
2. Fetal complications
3. Chronic condition which may complicate the pregnancy
4. Current use of drugs or alcohol/recent drug use or heavy alcohol use (month prior to learning of pregnancy)
5. History of preterm birth (<37 weeks)
6. History of low birth weight (<2500g)
7. Unsafe living environment (physical/sexual abuse, domestic violence, homelessness)
8. Tobacco use (current smoker or quit after learning of pregnancy)
9. Late entry into prenatal care (>14 weeks/missing 2+ prenatal appointments)
10. Hospital utilization during pregnancy (Emergency Department, antepartum admission; Labor and Delivery triage and/or observation)
11. Provider request for care management assessment
